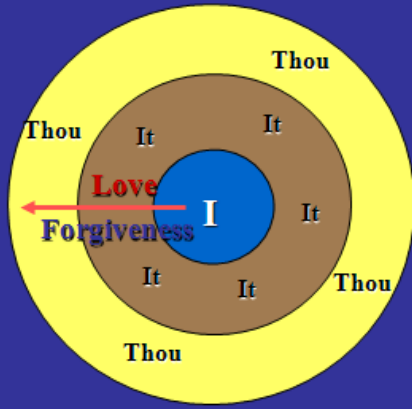

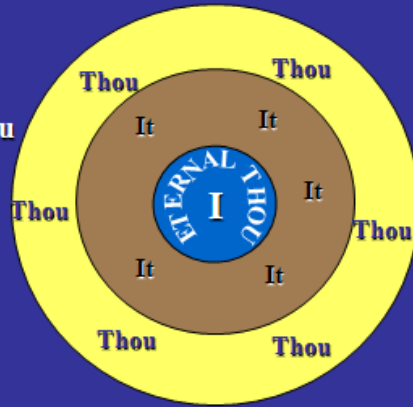

"I" and "Eternal Thou"

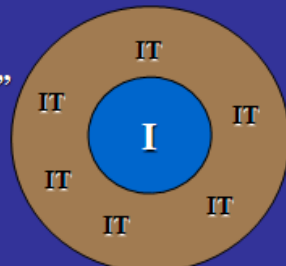
- loving unconditionally
