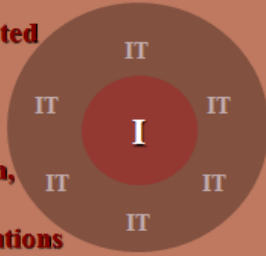


"I" and "It" (Subject-object)

- A view that permeates institutions

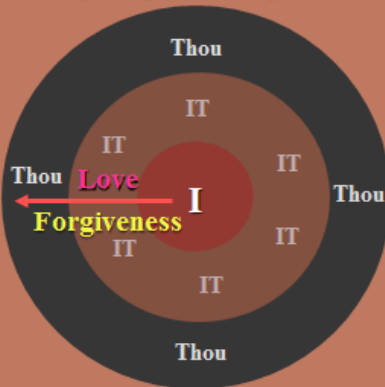

- Temporary

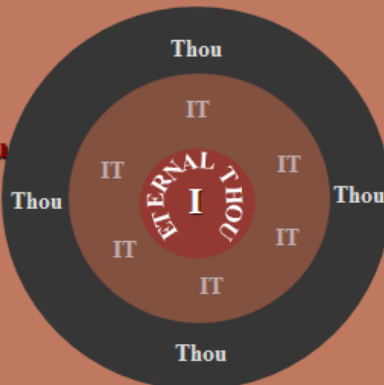
