

## Writing assignment for EDCU 2130

Your culminating assignment for this course is to write a paper on the subject **"Who am I as a teacher?"** This paper is all about you and nobody else.

This assignment's aim is to have you examine:

**1<sup>st</sup> the gifts you were born with as they relate to teaching.**

**2<sup>nd</sup> the strengths you see in yourself as they relate to teaching.**

Think about your gifts and why they are essential to **whom you are** as a teacher. Take time to **do some reflecting** and you may also want to call a parent, friend or someone who knows you well and ask them what gifts they see in you. Use personal examples as they come to your mind that may portray one or more of your gifts. Share those experiences or examples that have shaped you into the person you are today. This paper is a reflective paper so you will need to take time to organize your thoughts.

Lastly, write this reflective paper with you being the audience—not me. Do not write this paper "for a grade" rather write it to help you understand your journey to become a good teacher. It is **your journey** that is making you the teacher you are meant to be.
